Thank you for your interest in applying for a grant from The Arts of Starved Rock Country Fund. We are pleased to partner with non-profit organizations, schools, libraries and community groups who support the arts and arts programs.

Please note the following:

1. **Grant Approval** - All grant awards are subject to availability of funds and the impact the program, project or initiative will have in the community.
2. **Non-Profit Organizations** - Grants are available to non-profit organizations throughout LaSalle, Bureau and Putnam Counties. Proof of non-profit status is required, and a copy of your 501©3 letter from the IRS must be attached to your grant application.
3. **Schools, Libraries, Community Groups** – Grants must be used for charitable purposes that serve a broad range of your students, members and/or the community at large.
4. **Grant Cycles** – **There are two grant cycles per calendar year. Applications will be accepted April 1 thru May 1, with grant announcements on June 1. Payment will be made within ten days. Applications will also be accepted November 1 thru December 1, with grant announcements made January 2; payment will be made within ten days.**
5. **Application** – Please complete the attached application and attach any supporting documentation.
6. **Final Reports** – All Final reports are due to the SRCCF office no later than 30 days after the completion of the project, event or initiative. No additional awards will be granted unless the final report for an existing grant is received.
7. **Excess Grant Funds** – Any grant dollars not utilized for the stated purpose must be returned. Any excess grant dollars must be returned. All grant dollars must be expended prior to December 31 each year.
